Nice Trip



Throughout the Greater Region, the legal alcohol limit is 0.5‰ (g/l). For probationary drivers, the maximum alcohol limit is 0.2‰ in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and 0.0‰ in Germany. All regions might punish young drivers and professional drivers more strictly. In particular cases, you may be punished for driving under influence even below the legal thresholds.



Do take the long-term effects of alcohol into account. Sometimes, a good night's sleep may not be enough to lower the blood alcohol content sufficiently. In general, the blood alcohol level drops at the rate of 0.1‰ per hour.



Driving under the influence of other psychoactive drugs such as cannabis, heroin, cocaine, amphetamines, XTC etc. is banned in all the countries of the Greater Region. The police has the right to carry out on-site rapid testing (on saliva, sweat or urine) during routine traffic controls. Even if you do no longer feel any drug-related effects, the test might be positive and imply sanctions like the revocation of your driving licence, penal actions or even a criminal record.

Do not ever get behind the steering wheel under the influence of psychoactive substances.
