Sex is a matter of mutual consent. Do take into account though that the legal age of consent differs from country to country. In Germany, it is 14 years, 15 in France and 16 years in Belgium and Luxembourg.



Condoms will prevent unwanted pregnancy or paternity and protect you against sexually transmitted diseases. Always use condoms or dental dams, also for oral sex.



In case of an emergency: if contraception fails, the "morning-after pill" may prevent any unwanted pregnancy within 72 hours -- the earlier, the better. In Belgium, France and Luxembourg, the emergency contraceptive pill is available without prescription in pharmacies and counselling centres. In Germany, a written prescription is mandatory, so you will need to turn to a counselling centre or a medical doctor.



Various psychoactive substances such as alcohol, GHB/GBL, poppers or cocaine have disinhibitory effects, so make sure you practice safer sex. When going out, look after your friends.
