PARTY+ SEMINAR - 3rd- 4th May 2012

To share good practice and tools between stakeholders including health professionals, local decision makers and club representatives from cities and regions developing safer party Label or Charter.

PARTICIPANTS & SUBSCRIPTION

16 persons will be representatives of labels and charters composing the actual Party+ Network: Fêtez Clairs (France), Q de Festa! (Spain), Quality Nights (Belgium) and Safer Clubbing (Switzerland).

24 persons will be representatives of existing or emerging labels and charters but not yet members of Party +.

The participants to the seminars have to be technical or political representatives, health NGOs or club representatives. They should be involved in the development of the Label in their City/Region/Country and must be authorized to share openly about their experiences (good practice and difficulties).

- Travels and accommodation at your own cost.

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NEWIP FIELDWORK TRAINING SESSION - 3rd -5th May

OBJECTIVES

The objective of training session one is to train peers/professionals for the creation of a multidisciplinary European team to work at party settings. Volunteers trained will join one of two interventions in either Portugal or Croatia in summer 2012 to adapt their theoretical knowledge to the practical field (for details see section on interventions).
